MURAL MAP

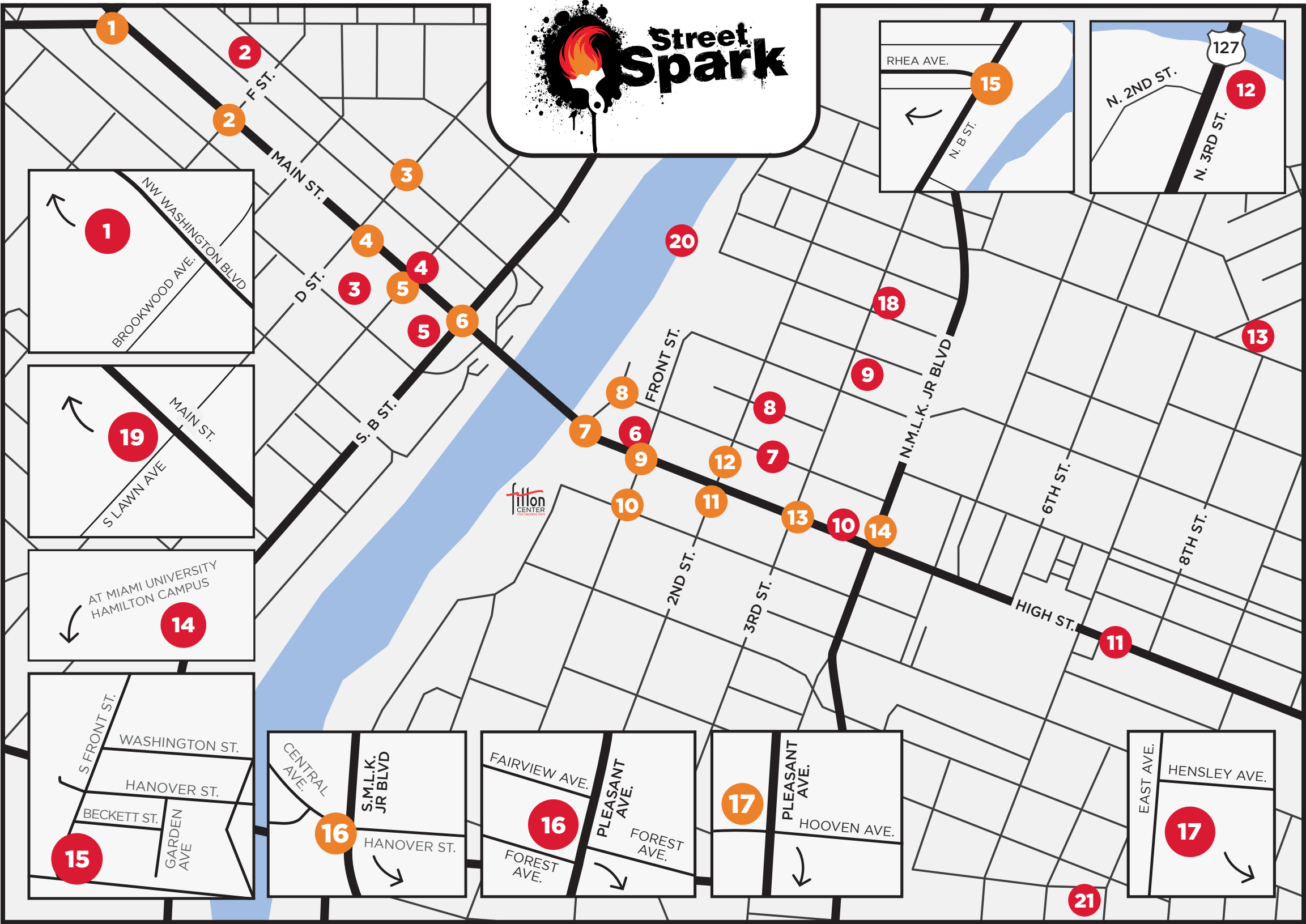


STREETSPARK, a public art program in partnership with the **Fitton Center for Creative Arts**, the **City of Hamilton** and the **Hamilton Community Foundation**, was founded to further the creative identity in Hamilton, Ohio, through exciting murals and public art projects.

The program creates engagement by producing **high-quality art**, providing opportunities for local artists and enhancing the visual appeal of the city.

Since the summer of 2016, **20 murals and 17 utility boxes** have been painted in a variety of styles. Each year artists are invited to submit a range of designs. The winning murals are chosen by a selection committee of local arts professionals and appreciators.
